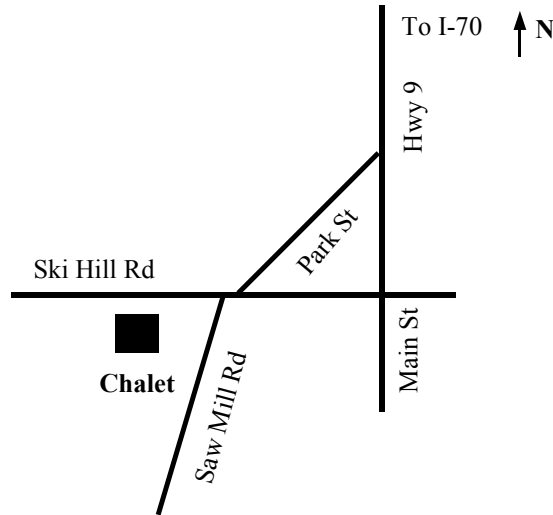

## The Club

The Schussbaumer Ski Club is a private sports and social club with its own chalet in Breckenridge. Membership is geared toward active, single adults. We maintain a 50/50 balance of men and women. Members enjoy alpine, telemark and cross-country skiing, snowboarding, snow shoeing, backcountry hut trips, hiking, mountain and road biking, kayaking and many other outdoor activities from the front door of the chalet. Breckenridge and Summit County also offer a variety of social and cultural activities year round. Music, arts, sports and culinary festivals abound. Along with the dining opportunities and nightlife found in the local area, the club hosts parties and dinners for members and guests at the chalet. Members consider the chalet their getaway and enjoy both the peace and quiet of the mountains and the friendship and camaraderie the club has to offer.



Every year the club hosts trips both in Colorado and international ski locations. Destinations have included Aspen, Crested Butte, Steamboat Springs, Taos, Banff, Gray Rocks, the Swiss and French Alps. Activities include skiing, rafting, canoeing, camping, biking, hiking, jazz festivals and backcountry huts.



## The Chalet

The 18 bedroom chalet sleeps 72 members and guests. It contains 7500 square feet on 4 levels. There is a walk in kitchen and dining room with ski/bike racks on the ground level. Men's sleeping rooms are on the 2nd floor, women's are on the 4th floor and the 3rd floor had a large party room with beer taps, a stone fireplace and a comfortable sitting room. No reservations are necessary to stay at the chalet. You don't have to check out by noon, and for a small fee, you can reserve a bed for a year. For a nominal fee, members can bring guests.

## The Cost

Annual dues are \$585.00, less than the cost of a weekend vacation during high ski season. Our costs are low because we rely on each member to share in the maintenance of the chalet. The mortgage is paid off and the club has a non-profit status.

## Membership Requirements

- 21 or over, singles only
- Permanent Colorado primary resident
- Attend 2 work parties per year
- Perform assigned clean up duties when staying at the chalet



## How do I join?

Participate in at least 3 club functions one of which must be an overnight at the chalet with members present. We hold social meetings in Denver twice a month in the winter and once a month in the summer. Visit the website or call the hotline for specifics. During the time we are getting to know one another, you need to obtain signatures from a minimum of 3 board members and get to know as many members as possible. You are now eligible to submit your application. Your membership will be activated after you are voted in and there is an opening. We are limited to 150 active members and maintain a 50/50 balance of men and women. During the time you are an active applicant or waiting for an opening, you are welcome to visit the chalet when members are present and pay the nightly guest fee.
